... hen she summons the courage to speak her difficult truth, she finds herself in a place built for intimidation, not comfort, for offenders, not children. She walks past police cars and tall fences; she sees officers in uniforms with guns at their sides. She stares up at strangers through bulletproof glass and makes her way down a sterile, noisy hallway to be questioned about the ugly thing that happened to her. **She feels afraid.**

he call of her courage echoes, searching for an answer. Heavy with the weight of her difficult truth, she and her caregiver are forced to self-navigate a fractured and complicated system. Not knowing how or where to begin, they feel overwhelmed as they try to find support to help them heal. With each twist and turn of the system, she is burdened with an increasing sense of guilt. "Is this my fault? Did I do wrong?" **She feels ashamed.**

hen her thoughts keep returning to her most painful memories and her sleep is plagued by dark nightmares, she is asked to put her mental health on hold. She sits on the waitlists for counselling and supports as her wellbeing deteriorates, avoiding the friends and activities that once brought her joy. She withdraws from school, family, and all the things she once loved. **She is suffering.**
