CHERRY-PINEAPPLE DUMP CAKE

Dump cakes are simple and fuss-free to make. Put your choice of fruit on the bottom, sprinkle your choice of dry cake mix on top, then top with butter. Try this recipe or other combinations. Let your taste buds guide you.

Ingredients

- One 21-ounce can cherry pie filling
- One 15-ounce can crushed pineapple
- 1 box white cake mix (18 ounces)
- 1 1/2 sticks (12 tablespoons) butter
- Whipped cream or ice cream, for serving

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C.)

Dump the cherry pie filling and crushed pineapple into a 9-by-13-inch baking dish. Stir together. Sprinkle the cake mix over the top of the fruit. Slice the butter into tablespoons and distribute evenly over the surface of the cake mix.

Bake until the top is brown and bubbly, approximately 45 minutes. Serve warm or cold with whipped cream or ice cream.

This recipe is very versatile. Follow the directions but instead of the cherry & pineapple some options are:

Peach Dump Cake: 1 large can peaches in syrup, ½ teaspoon cinnamon or to taste, **Black Forest Dump Cake:** 1 can cherry pie filling, 1 pkg. chocolate chips on top of pie filling, 1 box Devils food cake mix.

Blueberry Dump Cake: 4 cups fresh blueberries mixed with ½ cup white sugar & 1 teaspoon cinnamon; sprinkle 1 package yellow cake mix.
